**DESTINY USA HOSTS CORPORATE EXPRESS
“GREEN” INITIATIVE SUSTAINABILITY FAIR**

Purpose: Educate Companies Interested in Becoming “Greener” and Sustainable While Showing the Positive Financial Impact to the Bottom Line

Syracuse, New York – Destiny USA officials announced today that it will host the Corporate Express Sustainability Fair on Wednesday, June 4, 2008, from 10:30 AM until 2:30 PM, at the Carousel Center, on the 6th level Skydeck. Vendors from various product lines including office products, furniture and cleaning supplies will have exhibits on display and representatives will demonstrate, discuss and pass out information regarding their company’s sustainable product lines. Green advocates from the Destiny USA Sustainability Team and Corporate Express’ headquarters will be present to discuss their views and experiences on the environment, and to share information regarding how all companies can be more sustainable and attain a positive financial impact on their company’s bottom line.

“As the green industry emerges across the country, particularly here in Syracuse, many companies are being asked by their customers, senior executive teams, and shareholders, to operate as socially cognizant and model environmental stewards. The Corporate Express Sustainability Fair, will connect such companies with sustainable exhibitors who offer proven, practical recommendations, with innovative solutions that help businesses transform and position themselves into greener entities,” said Melissa Perry, Destiny USA’s Director of Sustainability.

Corporate Express provides customers with a single source of business products and services so that they can focus their resources, energy and time on their core business. Corporate Express helps organizations to save time and maximize their productivity. Headquartered in the Netherlands, Corporate Express NV generated 2007 annual sales of EUR 5.6 billion. The Company has a widespread global distribution network spanning North America, Europe and Australia, has close to 18,000 employees, and operations in 21 countries. Corporate Express NV is listed on Euronext Amsterdam (Euronext: CXP) and in New York (NYSE: CXP).

On February 27, 2007, Destiny USA closed on \$540 million in financing, secured through municipal underwriters Lehman Brothers and Citigroup with the sale of \$345 million in municipal bonds, along with a construction loan from Citigroup, to advance the first phase of the project, including the first ever issued, "Green Bonds." On the same day, Destiny USA delivered \$65.4 million to the City of Syracuse and Onondaga County to advance other economic development initiatives in the region.

Under direction from Destiny USA, Cianbro Corporation, the projects' construction manager, is interweaving technology while driving innovation, to construct the "greenest destination" in the USA. The 1.3 million square foot First Phase has a 10 acre footprint.
